Which LAMDA course should I study?

Performance Examinations: LAMDA's performance examinations use drama to develop self-confidence, physical presence and a strong speaking voice.

- **Acting** Developing a strong speaking voice and good memory skills by learning and performing monologues and duologues. Designed for **solo** or **duo** performances.
- **Devising** Developing creativity by exploring ideas and themes, and realising them through devised dramatic performances. Designed for **solo** or **duo** performances.
- **Musical Theatre** Enhancing self-confidence through singing and acting. Designed for **solo** or **duo** performances.

Communication Exams: LAMDA's communication examinations provide the opportunity to develop a clear speaking voice, positive body language and self-confidence by exploring different uses of spoken English.

- **Speaking Verse and Prose** Developing a strong speaking voice and memory skills, designed for individual candidates.
- **Speaking in Public** Developing essential skills for constructing and delivering talks, presentations and speeches. Designed for individual candidates.

Lessons take place during lunchtimes or from 4pm, Monday to Friday, in the Drama Department or Music School buildings. Learners can, where possible, choose a time convenient for them.

Lessons are conducted in solos, pairs or in groups of up to four. And assigned their own working industry professional.

Over the course of 1 academic year, students will receive 30 half hour lessons (10 per term).

How much does it cost?

- **LAMDA Solo Lesson** - £222 per term (£22.20 per lesson)
- **LAMDA Duo or Joint Solo Lesson** - £150 per term (£15 per lesson)

Fees include access to your own unique student portal.

Fees for **LAMDA** examinations are **not** included in the term fee above, you will be notified of the additional amount and invoiced. Exams will be held at King Edward's School during term time.

Exams are not compulsory for learners wanting to develop without taking a formal examination.

A full terms notice, in writing, is required when terminating lessons, otherwise one term's fees will remain payable. Once enrolled fees will not be refunded for any reason.
