At KES:

Born in 1895 in Henley-on Thames he came to KES as an orphan in 1907. He was later adopted by his guardian. He had a bad stammer, yet worked hard and was described as a good in his occupation in the kitchens. He left in 1911 to be a shop boy at an outfitters in Henley.

Date of Death: 23rd April 1916

Place: France

Buried: Bully-Grenay Communal Cemetery, Pas de Calais.

Barrysdale died of Bronchitis whilst serving on the Western Front. He had arrived in France with his regiment on 26th October 1915.
