Euan, who lived in Perth with his wife and two daughters, was diagnosed with a terminal grade 4 brain tumour in January 2014. He was a talented amateur photographer who pursued a career in health and safety, working for SSE, The National Trust for Scotland, Perth and Kinross Council and the Federation of Scottish Theatres.

A former drummer with one of Scotland's first 'funk ceilidh' bands, the '*Tartan Amoebas*', he worked part-time following the death of his sister in 2007, to gain time for family, friends, photography and the outdoor life. His love of Scotland and its scenery was demonstrated through the exhibition '*All roads lead to Here*' intended to raise money for the charities supporting Euan and his family, The Brain Tumour charity and Maggies.
