

John LUKER

At KES:

John was an orphan, both his parents having died in 1878. Born in Carmarthen in 1872 he came into the care of an uncle who sent him to KES in 1884. Described as a fair tailor he left in 1887 to a situation unknown.

Date and place of Death: 1942 Cornwall

There is no doubt that John Luker did serve in the First World War but appears not to have died until 1942.

He enlisted in the Royal Marine Light Infantry in 1890 and rose to the rank of Lance Sergeant. In the 1911 census he is a Lance Sergeant, married, and living in Devon. He had married Daisy Ellen in 1899. Probate for his death in 1942 confirms his widow as Daisy Ellen.
