



## **Norman MORRIS**

**Private. 7<sup>th</sup> Bn. Queen's Royal West Surrey Regiment**

### **At KES:**

Norman was one of 6 children, from Gravesend, whose father had died. His elder brother John also came to KES. Norman was admitted in 1906 and was described as good in the Band. When he left in 1910 he went straight into the Queen's Royal West Surrey Regiment as a bandsman.

**Date of Death: 18<sup>th</sup> November 1916**

**Place: France**

**Buried: Stump Road Cemetery, Grandcourt**

The details of Norman's death are unknown. However, his regiment was engaged in the latter stages of the Battle of the Somme; in particular the Battle of the Ancre from 13<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> November. This battle, the last attack before winter, was fought in the snow.
