Regimental Sergeant Major Queens Royal West Surrey

At KES:

Born in 1865 in Lambeth, George Curel was living at School, with his wife and family as Master Cook and Baker. He had been a Sergeant Cook in the Kings Royal Rifles between 1883 until 1904 when he was discharged and came to work at KES.

Date of Death: 5th November 1915

Place: England

Buried: All Saints Churchyard, Witley.

George Curel joined up in Guildford to the 6th Battalion Queens Royal West Surrey Regiment. He landed in France on 1st June 1915. It is unclear what happened to him whilst in France but it is certain that he returned to Aldershot where he died in the Connaught Military Hospital.
