At KES:

Paul was born in Fulham in 1896. Fatherless and his mother being unable to look after him, he came to KES in 1907. His occupation at school was in the band and he was described as good. He left in 1909 and there is no record of where he went. However a comment says he was "physically unfit"

Date of Death: 23rd August 1915

Place: Belgium

Buried: Divisional Cemetery, Ypres

He volunteered in September 1914. He was killed by a shell in a dugout near Ypres. The circumstances are unknown but there was continual fighting on the Ypres Salient for most of the war.
