## What you can expect from **THE SCHOOL**

- To endeavour to protect the members of the community

## What we expect of **PARENTS & GUARDIANS**

- To report promptly any COVID indicator symptoms
- Not to send any pupils presenting these symptoms into School without clearance
- Not to send affected children back into School until either we have received a negative test or 10 days have elapsed since the first symptoms
- To collect our children from School when it is possible to make prompt arrangements
- To comply with the isolation principles if required

## What we expect of **STAFF**

- To comply with and enforce COVID measures
- To continue to support and contribute to the development of COVID measures within the School
- To communicate appropriately on the basis of fact not rumour

## What we expect of **PUPILS**

- To comply with the expectations as set out by the school guidance regarding social distancing, the wearing of face protection and hand hygiene
- To communicate appropriately on the basis of fact not rumour
- To adhere to all usual academic expectations
