King Edward's is a thriving co-educational boarding and day school in Surrey, with 480 pupils aged from 11 – 18. Our School is a **beautiful 100 acre learning environment** which **inspires curiosity, ignites passions and prompts discovery**. We are the only Surrey boarding school with a train station **under 10 minutes walk away** and all of our boarding options are enabled by our excellent location. Direct trains run to **Clapham Junction** (45 minutes) and **London Waterloo** (55 minutes), **Guildford** (15 minutes) and **Woking** (30 minutes); our School is located very close to the **A3** and other major road networks as well as **Gatwick and Heathrow airports**.

We are a proudly diverse community with strong foundations rooted in **kindness, compassion and authenticity**; we aim for pupils to flourish **academically, socially and emotionally** through inspiring educational and pastoral journeys. We have a **proud history**, being founded in **1553** in the **City of London**; our pupils continue to take advantage of wide-ranging academic and co-curricular enrichment opportunities in our Capital city.

# BOARDING & YOUR FAMILY

Boarding at **King Edward's** is tailored to suit your family, whether that's your son arriving on a Monday morning and leaving for home on Friday afternoon or your daughter staying overnight on a Wednesday to accommodate her late hockey practice. Our boarding options are designed to be **flexible for you and your child**; evening drama rehearsals, revising with peers before an important exam or even avoiding a 3am drop off ahead of the School Ski Trip can all be made easier as you'll be confident in the knowledge that your child is **secure in a safe and supportive boarding environment**.

For your daughter or son, boarding enriches their **King Edward's** experience by further embedding them in the School community; deepening their **pastoral care** and opening opportunities for them to take part in a **wider range of activities** in the evenings or at weekends. **Boarding life is busy and fun**; flexi boarding is often actively sought out by pupils living within **easy commuting distance** as they enjoy the House camaraderie and **time spent together with friends** after School.

We have our own medical centre which is staffed during term time to maintain the highest standard of individual and group health, and to treat sickness and injury.

# BOARDING LIFE

Our Houses, including **dedicated spaces** for our youngest Year 7 and 8 pupils and our Sixth Form, are at the heart of our boarding community, with **House teams** being the first point of contact for parents and their children. A full **evening and weekend programme** is offered, including **'Big Trips' to London**, a range of on and off-campus activities and **free time and relaxation** in addition to more formal School activities.

## FULL BOARDING

Our full boarding programme provides 24/7 care for pupils living at King Edward's, including evening and weekend Boarders' activities offering a wide range of opportunities.

An Exeat programme is offered for pupils wishing to stay at School during these breaks, including on- and off-site activities, at a cost of £300.

## WEEKLY BOARDING

Our weekly boarding programme offers all the benefits of boarding from either Sunday night / Monday morning until Friday night / Saturday morning, depending on activities accessed on Saturdays, including our evening Boarders' activities.

## FLEXI BOARDING

Our flexi boarding opportunities are very well established at King Edward's and are booked via Houseparents on an ad-hoc basis. A reduced rate is charged for those pupils representing the School at events. Bundles of 10 flexi-boarding nights may also be booked in advance at a discounted cost, representing even better value for money for your family.
